To Whom it May Concern:

The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) has been conducting an investigation into the facts and circumstances surrounding the disappearance of George A. Smith IV, who was a passenger aboard the Brilliance of the Seas cruise ship, on or about July 5, 2005. In connection with the investigation, numerous records have been obtained from the Royal Caribbean Cruise Lines and a number of passengers, crew members and other potential witnesses have been interviewed. The records obtained indicate that you were either a passenger or crew member on this cruise.

To date, as indicated above, numerous individuals have been interviewed, some of whom have come forward with relevant, useful, and detailed information. In an effort to conduct as thorough an investigation as possible, the FBI intends to identify and interview persons who may have information regarding Mr. Smith's disappearance.

As part of the FBI's investigation, we are contacting passengers and crew members to determine if they have any information pertaining to the incident, or know of anyone who may have information concerning the disappearance of George A. Smith IV. Accordingly, if you believe you have any information about this incident, or know someone else who does, please contact the FBI, New Haven Division, at 1-800-435-1284, or forward a letter to the FBI at the above address. All responses will be kept confidential to the maximum extent permitted under law.
